### Exercise #1

1. Read John 5:26. Here we are clearly taught that our God is a living God. According to this verse, does God derive His life from any sources outside of Himself?

Read Acts 17:25

- a. According to this verse, does God need anything from man?
- b. Who gives all men and women life and breath?

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### **Exercise #2**

1. Read Psalm 90:2
  - a. According to this verse, how long has God existed? How long will He exist?
  - b. Was there ever a time when God was not God? Will there ever be a time in the future when He is not God.

2. Read Psalm 139:7-12 and Jeremiah 23:23-24.

According to these passages, is God present in only one place at a time?  
Where can God be found?

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### **Exercise #3**

1. Read Malachi 3:6 and James 1:17.  
What do these passages teach about God?

2. Read Isaiah 40:13-14.

According to this passage, has anyone ever “instructed” God?  
Has He ever grown or progressed in His knowledge?

### **Exercise #4**

1. Read James 1:13.  
According to this verse, can God be tempted by evil?

2. Read Job 34:12.

What does this passage teach about God?

3. Read Habakuk 1:13.

According to this verse, is it possible for God to tolerate evil?

4. Read Isaiah 59:1-2.

Because God is holy, how does our personal sin impact our relationship with Him?

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
